


- 3. While wearing eye protection, drill an 8 mm hole through the tailgate at each of the four center-punched marks:
 - To prevent damage to the roof panel, wrap masking tape around the drill bit at a point 10 mm (0.4 in.) away from the tip.
 - To prevent damage to the wire harness and the edge of the roof, move and secure the harness with tape, and apply tape to the edge of the roof panel.
 - First drill with a 3 mm bit, then finish with an 8 mm bit.
 - After drilling, remove any burrs from the edges of all holes and apply touch-up paint. Allow the touch-up paint to dry thoroughly before proceeding to the next step.



 Position the rear tailgate deflector on the tailgate, and install the two cap nuts and two washer-bolts. Torque the washer-bolts and cap nuts to 7.0 N·m (5 to 7 lbf-ft) securely. Push the rubber protector back into position, if necessary.



5. Remove all of the masking tape.
